Not long ago, wounded veteran Jake Simmons arrived at the Adaptive Sports Foundation (ASF) unsure if he would ever ski again.

After sustaining an injury during his service, the idea of returning to the slopes felt completely out of reach. But with support from ASF's volunteer instructors, Jake got into a mono-ski for the very first time at this season's Bob Stubbs Warriors in Motion® Winter Sports Weekend, and by the end of the weekend, he wasn't just skiing independently, he was thriving.

Just three weeks later, Jake returned to the ASF to refine his skills before traveling to Colorado with family and friends to take on the Winter Park Resort. Today, he's skiing mountains across the country!

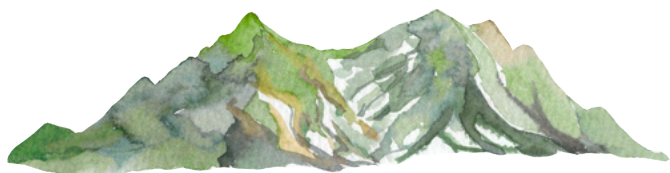
Through year-round outdoor recreation, education, support, and community, ASF empowers individuals to move beyond perceived limitations and build confidence that carries into every aspect of their lives.

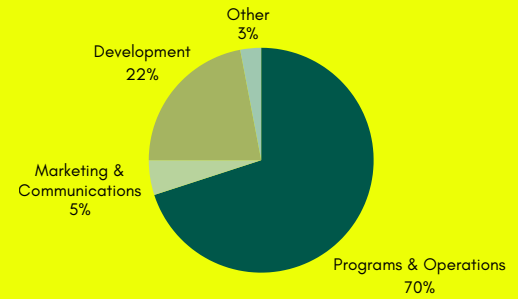

WE ARE ATHLETES

With funding from the KFC Foundation and HUDSY, the ASF produced the short film **WE ARE ATHLETES**. This inspiring documentary follows two ASF athletes: Farryl, a 10-year-old with cerebral palsy determined to ski independently, and Matthew, a veteran in his 30s navigating life after a severe brain injury while seeking renewed purpose. **WE ARE ATHLETES** has been selected for five festivals and was awarded "Best Inspirational Film" from the New York International Film Awards.

PROGRAMS

Winter Adaptive Ski & Snowboard Lessons at WMC

The ASF offers adaptive skiing and snowboarding lessons for children and adults with cognitive and physical disabilities and chronic illnesses. Students can choose either half or full-day lessons that take place at the Windham Mountain Club.

Race Camps & Seasonal Programs

The ASF provides training for skiers and snowboarders who already have experience and want to develop their skills for recreational and competitive racing.

Summer Adaptive Ski & Snowboard Lessons at Big Snow

Big Snow is the ideal learning environment for folks that are new to adaptive skiing and snowboarding. The ASF offers two-hour lessons at the indoor skiing facility throughout the summer.

Warriors in Motion®

The ASF offers U.S. Veterans with disabilities opportunities to participate in summer and winter adaptive sports programs alongside their peers.

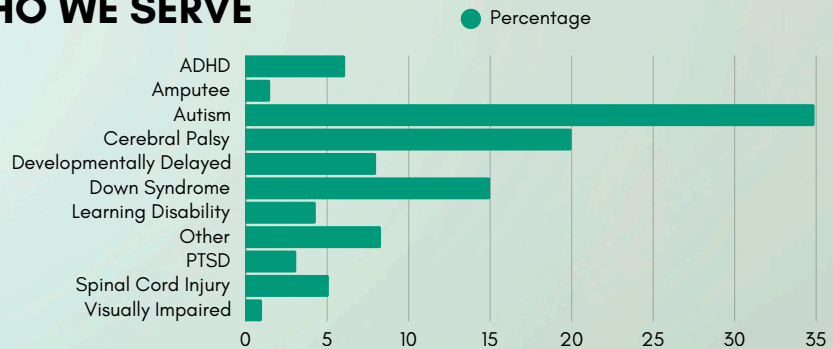
Skateboarding & Multi-Sport Summer Camps
